

# A VERY GLASSY ADDITION TO DOWNTOWN SEATTLE

Workers finish work on the facade of Fifteen Twenty-One Second on Monday. Seattle's tallest residential tower, with 38 floors and 143 homes, is on the west side of Second Avenue between Pine and Pike streets and a half-block from Pike Place Market. The 440-foot glass-and-steel tower will be the first tall and slender tower to be completed under the city's new downtown zoning regulations, which encourage urban density through taller and more slender buildings.
